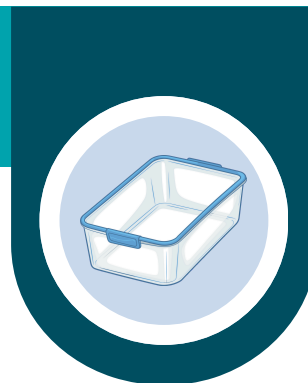


SAFE Emergency Kit Resources

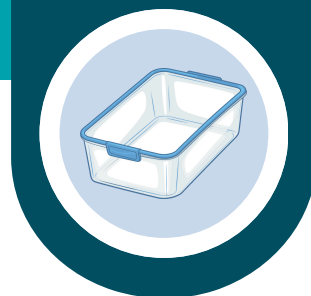
Build your own kits

Links are provided for your reference – pricing and availability is volatile, so please do your own comparison shopping.



Item	Notes	Link
Bin	Any bin or bag is fine	13qt tote – 8pk
Bleach	It's hard to find small bottles that fit in the container – any bleach that is 5% – 7.5% sodium hypochlorite as the only active ingredient is ok	Search 11oz or 24oz Clorox on Staples or Dollar General – availability is spotty
Spray Bottle	Any 24oz spray bottle with trigger is fine. Another size will require recalculating sanitizer bleach:water ratio	Kit bottles – 12pk Amazon option – 4pk
Fridge Thermometer	Any analog fridge thermometer is fine	Kit thermometer Amazon option Webstaurant option
Food Thermometer	Choose an analog thermometer with a wrench integrated into the case	Kit thermometer Webstaurant option
Can Opener	Search P-51 can opener – there are a lot of options	Kit can opener
Hand Sanitizer	Any 8 – 12oz hand sanitizer is fine – as long as it is at least 60% alcohol	Kit sanitizer
Measuring Spoon	Any that include both 1 tbsp and ½ tsp measures	Amazon Option Check your local dollar store

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Item	Notes	Link
Water Purification Tablets	Instructions in the pocket guide are for Aquatabs brand	Kit option - check multipack pricing
Ice Bags	Search for reusable ice bags - should hold 2.5 - 5lbs of ice and include a handle	Cheapest kit option
Dropper	Search 3ml transfer pipette - plan on 3-5 per kit	Kit dropper Amazon option
Sandwich bags	Zipper sandwich bags to put the droppers in.	Whatever is on sale is fine.
