

Emergency Supplies Checklist

Store your kit in a cool, dry location and check it annually. Replace expired items as needed.



This kit contains:

- ☐ Emergency Water Purification Kit (check expiration dates)
- ☐ Ice bag (fill and freeze before the storm)
- ☐ Manual can opener
- ☐ Analog food thermometer
- ☐ Analog fridge thermometer
- ☐ Hand sanitizer (check expiration date)
- ☐ Measuring spoon
- ☐ Droppers
- ☐ Spray bottle to mix bleach disinfectant solution for cleaning
- ☐ Bleach (check expiration date)

Other basic supplies to have on hand:

- ☐ Drinking water – one gallon per person per day minimum, 1/2 - 1 gallon per day per pet (3-day to 2-week supply)
- ☐ Non-perishable food items (3-day to 2-week supply)
- ☐ Sanitation and personal hygiene items (garbage bags, soap, toilet paper)
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Battery powered or hand-crank radio (preferably a NOAA weather radio)
- ☐ Extra batteries
- ☐ First aid kit
- ☐ Multi-purpose tool
- ☐ Chargers for phones and fully charged power banks
- ☐ Family and emergency contact information

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Other basic supplies to have on hand:

- ☐ Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- ☐ Duct tape
- ☐ Disposable tableware and paper towels
- ☐ Rain gear
- ☐ Extra clothing, hat, sturdy shoes, and work gloves
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Extra cash
- ☐ Whistle

Specific to your family:

- ☐ Medical supplies (medications, hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, etc)
- ☐ Infant supplies (bottles, formula, diapers, etc.)
- ☐ Pet supplies (food, collar, leash, carrier, etc.)
- ☐ Appropriate food for all family members with dietary restrictions
